The Harbor at Little Beach is in full swing with many boats coming in and out of the harbor each day. The water service had to be shut off as there is a leak underground. Repairs have been ordered and the service will be restored as soon as the repairs are made. Thank you for your patience on this.

Although the summer is in full swing, work still continues at Kelly Beach. An additional bike rack has been added, power washing of the entire boardwalk is completed, working on eliminating windblown sand on the boardwalk, new faucet at foot wash, and working to obtain a price to build benches at end of ramp and near the bulletin board. Please remember to pull over as much as possible when dropping someone off, especially on weekends when bus is trying to get through. Your cooperation in providing the guard with your address is also appreciated.

On Tuesday, July 19 beginning at 10am, about 20+ players, coaches, etc. from Ocean State Waves baseball team will be doing beach cleanups at Little Beach and Kelly Beach as a community service project. Bonnet will be providing the team gloves, bags, and water. All trash collected will be deposited into dumpster at the CC. Please thank them if you happen to see them.
