WHO NEEDS TO BE CERTIFIED?

- 1) Anyone born on or after Jan 1, (1986), who operates a vessel with a motor larger than 10-horse power.
- 2) Anyone who operates a personal watercraft (Jet ski/ wave runner), regardless of age.
