

August 27, 2021 Correspondence from CRMC

As I mentioned in our phone call, **I see nothing in your 10 year Assent that states that the breachway must be kept open year round.** In my recent email to Lisa, I stated that the breachway very likely closes up naturally as the season progresses – these pond breachways often open and close and even move their location throughout the year.

Attached please find the entire 2015 file associated with your 10 year maintenance Assent. This Assent was granted to maintain the culverts under the road and the breachway for **flood alleviation.** I do not see restrictions limiting this maintenance to a certain number of times per year, so, **as the breachway is currently naturally closed post Tropical Storm and the pond is currently rather high, if the pond gets higher and flooding becomes an issue, the Assent allows the District to open the culverts and breachway (subject to the limitations and stipulations of the Assent).**
