

## Bonnet Shores ByLaws' Committee Minutes

### Zoom

**Attendees:** Chair Carolyn DiLeo, Faith LaSalle, Deb Pannullo, Nancy Cordy, Mark Michaelson, Lloyd Albert, and Carole Duffy. Two residents were aboard on zoom.

**Call to Order:** Chair DiLeo called the meeting to order at 6:38 PM.

**Ratify minutes:** Mark **moved** to accept the minutes with a small wording correction; 2<sup>nd</sup> Faith. **Motion** passed 7-0. (The amended wording is reflected in the final copy sent to SOS.)

**Zoom** procedures: audience participation with residence verification will be accepted at the close of each discussion

### Old Business:

- **Ordinance VII Dogs** (discussion can be accessed at the BS website streaming Bylaws" Committee

At least an hour was spent debating the tenets of this Ordinance including input from residents. Finally, a **motion** was made by Faith stating" *that the current law concerning dogs on Kelly Beach would remain in effect at this time until the Ordinance would be placed on the Council agenda during the summer months when the entire community could respond to further research including legal information and input from information from other communities.*" 2<sup>nd</sup> Lloyd. **Motion** passed 7-0. Prior to this vote, Lloyd moved to accept Ordinance VII with additional research; 2<sup>nd</sup> Nancy. **Motion** approved 7-0.

- **Ordinance VIII Rentals** This Ordinance led to very long discussions during two meetings with extensive research. Nancy **moved** to accept Ordinance VIII with amendments; 2<sup>nd</sup> Faith. **Motion** approved 7-0. (Please refer to the meeting recording on the BS website for exact discussions).
- **Ordinance IX Abandoned Vehicles** Further discussion and voting was tabled until the next meeting waiting for clarification from the Harbor master because abandoned watercraft might fall under the umbrella of this Ordinance.
- **Ordinance X Harbor:** Nancy **moved** to accept this Ordinance; 2<sup>nd</sup> Faith. **Motion** passed 7-0.

### New Business:

- Mar. 15<sup>th</sup> meeting will be used for clearing up all loose ends
- Expect to present all Ordinances' revisions and commentary to Council at April meeting. There will also be an E-blast to community as well.
