Meeting Minutes

Call to Order

Council Chair Lenny Mercier called the Council meeting to order at 7:35 pm. Those in attendance included Council Members: Janice McClanaghan, Bill Delgizzo, John Pariseault, Terry Fracassa, and Matt Mannix. District Manager Erin Rooney, Tax Collector Helen Patience, Harbormaster Mike Tortolani, and Clerk Carole Duffy were also present.

Pledge of Allegiance

The Assembly recited the Pledge of Allegiance along with observing a moment of silence for the men and women serving in the Armed Forces.

<u>Urgent Business</u>: Two building plans were submitted for review: 37 Lake Rd (NR 751 &752) .Motion by M.Mannix; 2nd

J.McClanaghan to accept the plan given it met all of the Narragansett regulations. Motion passed 4-0 as J.Pariseault recused himself and T. Fracassa abstained. J.McClanaghan moved to accept the plans for 16 Richard Smith Rd (NS 324) with the same conditions; 2nd J.Pariseault. Motion passed 5-0 as T.Fracassa abstained. T.Fracassa stated that all new construction should enhance the Bonnet community citing, especially, underground utility wires. He suggested that he and M.Mannix work on creating an Ordinance about utility wires.

Ratification of May, 2014 Minutes:

Motion: M.Mannix made a motion to accept the May minutes; 2nd by T Fracassa. Discussion: none. Motion passed: 5-0. Motion: J.McClanaghan moved to accept the Organizational Meeting minutes with the correction of Barone to Varrone 2nd M.Mannix. Discussion: none. Motion passed 6-0

Committee Reports

- a) Beautification Committee L. Mercier reported that Shelly Sousa (bus driver) will be maintaining the gardens and triangles; a suggestion was made to advertise for a gardener on the website. A resident cited the poor condition of Namcook and Col. JG as in need of much work. Discussion continued about the need for gardening professional to assess the triangles and create a plan which could then be maintained by volunteers.
- b) Beach Committee / Security— see Janice McClanaghan's attached reports. J.Pariseault commended Janice for the great beach work. A resident asked about cleaning Little Beach of seaweed. Reply... almost impossible as the jetty tends to trap the seaweed but she will speak to Phil Smith about possible removal options.
- c) Public Works no report
- d) Social Committee: L.Mercier reported that a Beach Social will be held at the Dunes Cub on 9/19/14. Winter dinner @ Quonset O club on 12/6/14
- e) Pond: T. Fracassa spoke about the Phragmite issues in the ponds: it is a difficult and expensive problem because CRMC requires a comprehensive plan from the Council about Phragmite abatement. He continued with remarks about the proposed BSBC sewer installation along the causeway to the pumping station which could be a jumping off point for discussion of Phragmite elimination in conjunction with the sewer line project. The stakeholders in this project include: CRMC, Narragansett, BSFD, and Audubon
- f) Harbor Committee: M. Tortolani reported: one mooring in jeopardy for nonpayment; there is a policy about deceased members passing their moorings on...see moorings ordinances. Waiting mooring list: top five are asked to pay the mooring fee to commit to their intention of accepting a mooring when offered. The waiting list fee is\$20.
- g) Traffic: J.Pariseault reported that 25 MPH signs had been painted on some key roads; pricing of radar detectors for telephone poles will be explored by NPD. A resident suggested that crosswalks should also be marked at Fairway and Bonnet Shores Rd: questions about paving of Parkman, Roxbury, Canopus and Nassau...M.Mannix will obtain a schedule; resident asked if speed tables were dead and response was "Not yet". "They are not off the table but these other measures will be tried first." All Council members except M.Mannix are maintaining their support for speed tables.
- h) By-Laws/ Ordinances /Bonnet Days / Benches Report: see M. Mannix's attached reports. Special thanks to volunteers. Following remark was in response to mention of Ordinance revision. Resident mentioned broken glass on road after trash pickup and it was recommended that the number of the truck be recorded and then a solution can occur i) Trash Report: no report
- Tax Collector's Report see report; collections at \$ 15,700 to date

District Manager's Report – E. Rooney reported on the following items: 20 new recycle bins & 10 trash carts (96) @ \$75; A/C in CC is in need of new parts (age 1990); blood Drive on Thurs.24th; yard sale...7/19/14; bulky trash...7/23/14; life guards and Camp ...good E.Rooney was asked to inquire with Narragansett about plan for house at Bayberry and Withington due to safety issues. Kudos to Erin and Matt for Bonnet Days from T. Fracassa. M.Mannix asked about tax sale redemption certificates. Natalie McDonald will be asked about Redemption Certificates from 2008 (NR 1042)

- 3. Discussion ensued about increasing security on the roads; we have posted application for detail work at NPD for weekends. Question about golf carts and regulations...police don't seem to be enforcing reg.s unless confronted with the golf cart. M.Mannix will look into getting a GSO for Bonnet as suggested by B.Delgizzo. L. Mercier asked about cost for a constable...\$40 per wk and duration

B. Gelgizzo raised the question of hiring a professional to assess landscaping issues and it was suggested that B. Delgizzo and Roz Thomas prepare a RFP for landscaping for next year's budget

B.Delgizzo ventured into the communication arena in Bonnet asking about how to reach each family electronically for a variety of reasons: safety and regulations T.Fracassa supports enforcement of our regulations.

• Ordinances Committee. During the past few years, the Fire District Council has revised and updated its ordinances, many of which had not been revised since the 1980s. Since 2011, the council has revised 5 of its 10 ordinances. In the next year, the By-Laws Committee will work on the remaining five ordinances to ensure that all ordinances have been reviewed by the council and the community. Ordinance VI, which governs the removal of trash, has not been revised since the new trash program was implemented. Therefore, the next ordinance to come before the council for updating/revision/approval will be Ordinance VI and it will be written to reflect the changes to trash collection since it was last revised and approved in 1984.

Matt – unfortunately, I have no knowledge of what Dave may have discussed with you or Paul, but the work being done now is the maximum that CRMC would approve. We have to follow their standards for "shoreline erosion". The stones being placed are the largest that CRMC would approve, and are fairly comparable with what the Coast Guard House placed. Remember that this is a road edge protection program (that only came about because of Sandy), not a seawall to protect houses. That would be an entirely different scope of work with CRMC, and would require a much bigger budget...

Was at the site today, and it looks pretty good. The area between the large rocks and the road edge will be filled in, and smaller rocks will also be used in the voids to help stabilize things. For traffic safety reasons, we would not place the large rocks right against the edge of pavement – someone would hit one for sure.
