Misquamicut Fire District shall be so qualified as an elector regardless of whether the inhabitant owns such taxable real property."

Shady Harbor: "resident (as defined by RIGL 17-1-3/1) within the District for at least thirty (30) days prior to the date of the Annual Meeting or special meeting and who shall be registered to vote with the proper authorities of the Town of Charlestown at least thirty (30) days prior to the date set for the Annual Meeting or special meeting."

AND in each the second qualification is owner of real property or taxable real property, to accommodate those who do not have a voting domicile in the state.
