## **Bonnet Shores Fire District**Launch Ramp Regulations

- 1. Every vessel using the launch ramp or dock must have a Bonnet Shores Fire District Permit sticker affixed in the proper place.
- 2. The boat ramp with have a combination pad lock. The combination will be emailed only to mooring holders/boat ramp users and will change throughout the boating the season. Please do not share the combination with others and please keep your email address current.
- 3. The launch ramp gate **must** be re-locked immediately after use.
- 4. The dock is for loading and launching only (15 minutes max.) or the vessel may be removed at the owner's expense.
- 5. Do not leave unattended fuel on the dock.
- 6. Swimming or diving from the dock is prohibited.
- 7. The dock and harbor area are designated as a no wake zone with a speed limit not to exceed 5 MPH.
- 8. No person shall operate any vessel in a reckless or negligent manner so as to endanger the life, safety, or property of any person.
- 9. Maximum of 30-minute parking on road at the launch ramp area for loading or launching only.
- 10. Vessel trailers may not be parked on the beach.
- 11. Personal Watercraft Operator Certification must be presented prior to obtaining a Launch Ramp permit for that type of vessel.
- 12. Failure to abide by these rules and regulations may result in revocation of the Bonnet Shores sticker and /or removal of the vessel at owner's expense.
- 13. All watercraft using the launch ramp must have a state registration sticker and registration numbers clearly displayed on the hull of the vessel. Per Coast Guard Regulation 33 CFR 173.15.
