Lifeguard Job Description and Responsibilities

Lifeguards are responsible for the general overall safety of the waterfront area, responding to water related emergencies as well as accidents, injuries or other types of emergencies affecting the public safety within the beach area of the Fire District.

Individuals must be at least sixteen (16) years of age. Previous lifeguarding experience is a plus.

Individuals must commit to employment for the season: Beach opening: late June through Labor Day, weekdays and weekends. Hours 10 am -5 pm

Applicant must possess aquatic specialization certifications:

- American Red Cross (ARC) Lifeguard or equivalent
- ARC Standard First Aid Certification or equivalent,
- ARC CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer or equivalent.
- Applicant must hold a R.I. State Lifeguard Certification card that is valid through June 2025.
- Applicant must demonstrate the ability to fulfill the physical demands of the assigned work.
